INFORMATION FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS

PLEASE NOTE:

A student activity fee of

- **€120.00** for an individual pupil
- **€200.00** for 2 students
- **€250.00** for 3 or more students in school

is payable when registering students.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

We encourage parents/guardians to pay using our online payments system Easy Payments Plus (<https://www.carrigcs.ie/payments/>). If you have multiple students in the school you can make a combined payment by clicking into your account and selecting the relevant number of students.

Please note, if you are the parent/guardian of an incoming student that does not have siblings in the school already, you can pay by selecting "Students not currently in the school" in the Easy Payments Plus section of the website. We would appreciate payment by June of this year. Payments may also be made in cash / cheque at the main school office.

This fee contributes towards:

- **Reducing** costs of the school's extra-curricular activities programme
- The cost of **house examinations** for the forthcoming school year (**excluding** pre – state / mock examinations in 6th year which will be billed for separately in early 2025)
- Photocopying including copyright licence, school text messaging, use of the vsware app etc.
- Affiliation and entry fees for clubs and societies
- Individual pupil insurance

TRANSITION YEAR:

*Due to the nature of the Transition Year Programme **further costs** will be incurred at the start of the 2024/2025 academic year. A normal year would see a further cost of approximately €250 per TY pupil. Further communication will issue to the relevant students in due course.*

STATE EXAM STUDENTS (Yr. 6 2024/25):

A charge for examination papers / corrections will be issued in January 2025. This charge will be €100 per student in 6th Year.
